



REVISED HOSPITAL VISITATION

ONE VISITOR ALLOWED PER DAY

BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 11:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Effective immediately, Emergency Hospital Systems will allow **one in-person visitation per day with a hospital patient between the hours of 11:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.**

Visitor's must complete a health screening before entering the hospital and wear personal protective equipment (PPE), at all times, while visiting a patient. The hospital will provide the visitor with a gown and surgical mask. The visitor is required to provide their own N95 mask, if desired.

Emergency Hospital Systems can deny entry to a visitor who fails or refuses to submit to or meet the requirements of a health screening administered by the hospital; or wear personal protective equipment that meets the hospital's infection control and safety requirements in the manner prescribed by the hospital. **The visitor is required to remain in the patient's room during the duration of the visit.**

Emergency Hospital Systems is not subject to civil or criminal liability or an administrative penalty if a visitor contracts or spreads an infectious disease while on the hospital's premises.

If a visitor is for any reason denied in-person visitation because of a determination made by the patient's attending physician, or does not meet the in-patient visitation requirements, the hospital shall provide, each day, a detailed update of the patient's condition to the visitor, family representative or patient's agent (power of attorney), provided at the time of in-patient or out-patient admission.

ADMITTANCE ONLY TO THE FOLLOWING

- One legal guardian of a patient who is a minor (18 years of age or under).
- An attorney or other legal authorized representative of a patient.

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
