



**COMMUNITY VACCINATION BOOSTER UPDATE
TEXAS EMERGENCY HOSPITAL VACCINE HUB
NOW PROVIDING PFIZER-BIONTECH OR MODERNA BOOSTER VACCINES TO
18 YEARS AND OLDER
NOVEMBER 22, 2021**

On November 19, 2021, the CDC Director endorsed the CDC Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices' (ACIP) expanded recommendations for booster shots to include all adults ages 18 years and older who received a Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna vaccine at least six months after their second dose.

Our Vaccination Hub continues to provide the Pfizer-BioNTech Covid-19 vaccine for first and second dose administrations. Pfizer-BioNTech and Moderna booster shots are available, and an individual may choose which vaccine they receive as a "mix-and-match" booster dose. Individuals who received a Covid-19 vaccination are eligible at 6 months or more after their series.

NO APPOINTMENT IS REQUIRED TO RECEIVE YOUR VACCINATION OR BOOSTER SHOT. Individuals will be required to bring their vaccination card with them when receiving their second administration or booster of the Covid-19 vaccine, along with their identification and insurance card (if applicable).
